All of our rescues are spayed and neutered, microchipped, vaccinated, dewormed, and when applicable, tested for heartworm, lyme and erlichia.

All dogs go to their new home with a new leash and collar and an information packet. This donation enables us to continue our rescue efforts, and the donation is non-refundable after seven days.
